PROJECT

Full Mechanical and Electrical services for Castle Court and Whitestones, two new 40 bed homes for the elderly, operated by Derbyshire County Council.

SERVICES PROVIDED

Under the £1.0m contract, PWP installed a comprehensive package of services particularly designed for the elderly, including:

- Power, heating with low surface temperature radiators for safety, lighting, mains and submains distribution
- Sanitaryware and plumbing, including assisted facilities, kitchen and toilet ventilation
- Fire and disabled alarms, nurse call systems, door entry security controls and lighting protection.

In Castle Court purpose-built homes offer residents more individual living space, more communal space including large lounges, a conservatory, a courtyard area and a modern kitchen with laundry facilities. Each resident now has their own bedroom including en-suite facilities and each room has an individual patio area.

Whitestone residents have a room of their own with en-suite facilities and either their own patio or balcony. One of the rooms is a double for use by a couple wishing to share.

The home also boasts its own hairdressing salon, a hobbies and activities room with a computer suite, a rehabilitation and residents kitchen, a treatment room, an adapted bathroom, a conservatory, an accessible garden and courtyard.
